Budget? What budget? On November 30th, the membership will be asked to vote on the budget for the 2023-2024 year. What does this mean to you?

Our budget is the financial plan that the board adopts for the year ahead. It is our annual spending plan. By category, it details where our money will go and how much money we expect to take in. The budgeting process also includes a review of past results for comparisons.

2023-24 Budget Proposal

In this fiscal year which ends May 31, 2024 we are projecting a budget deficit. The summary of this forecast is in the included table. We project that our dues, similar to last year, will continue to be lower than in pre-pandemic years. A&E expenses will be probably be higher due to subsidies to keep event prices lower. Alpine and cross-country bus expenses are the biggest unknown as usual. For budget purposes we are assuming an increase in the buses this year over last year but this may be wrong.

The net result is a projected loss of \$14,900. We already know that Volleyball made much more than forecast so the loss may be closer to \$10,000. But considering we had large net surpluses during the pandemic years a loss of this magnitude can easily be absorbed. The Board of Directors recommends the approval of this proposed budget.
