2021/2022 OC SKI CLUB ALPINE Trips Update

It's official.... Group Travel will be much different this year. 1st we have the resorts accommodating those travelers who had to cancel last year for Covid reasons, 2nd the resorts & airlines lost revenue which they are going to try to make up, and 3rd - there's a lot of pent-up travel emotions that will need a "fix" to relieve the stress of not travelling/skiing for a year. So, we are going to run trips – they will be great trips just as our small ones last Winter were – but the base price is going to be a bit higher if we want to stay at properties higher than a Motel-6 and lift tickets will be much different. I am going to explore some smaller group travel and look to the Fall of 2022 for a New Zealand or Chile trek.

The resorts do not want to offer reasonable group ticket rates (Beaver Creek – mid January is \$860 for a five day single mountain ticket) but push us to the Epic or Ikon passes. I am going to be fair to our members and book 2 weeks of each. I've already signed an Epic (Beaver Creek) and about to sign an IKON (Utah, 2 canyons resorts). I am researching 1 more mountain of each pass. There will be Sunday River, an Ikon, as is Loon (NH). In addition I hope to bring back EPIC Mountains: Mount Snow and Stowe while adding NH (Attitash & Wiildcat). My hopes for Ikon mountains are NH mdweek (Loon), Tremblan, Lake Placid (Spring trip) and Sunday River (signed).

My recommendation, after attending a virtual travel symposium last week, is to buy a local Epic pass, if not a full blown one so that you can get to Stowe, Mount Snow, Okemo, Hunter etc... upgrade it if you think that you would be interested in a week long trip. Same goes for Ikon... Even if it is not an OC trip – if you and 9 other friends want to travel I can help to secure group rates for air/lodging!!!!

Watch the website and social media pages, or just shoot me an email for updates... More info will be flowing in the next couple of weeks. Including the return of online trip openings in August/September

Weekend trips will require a \$75 deposit + paypal fees (\$2.75)

Sunday River & NH trips will require a \$100 deposit + paypal fees (\$3.50)

Weeklong trips will require a \$150 deposit + paypal fees (\$5)

Your deposit will be fully refundable (but not the pp fee) until a predetermined cutoff date; this date is determined by the resort and our contract. At the time of the cutoff you will then make the decision to drop out & receive your refund or to pay the remainder of the deposit which will then fall under the normal cancellation policies of the Club.

Here is a summary of the trips we want to offer (Yellow indicates signed contract)

- 1. <u>Mount Snow, Dec 17 19, 2021</u>: Our annual Lessons & Luxury trip. This is a Driveup, Family friendly trip with free lessons to those who would like them. The Lodging is ski-in/ski-out with standard hotel rooms (no cooking), studios (Kitchenette), 1 bedroom (bdrm, bath, living room, kitchen). This will allow you to return to your room for breaks and/or meals if the ski lodges present a problem. **(EPIC)**
- 2. New Year's Eve trip in December/January. My hope is to return to Quebec City for skiing at Mt Ste Anne and Le Massif but if we cannot cross the border, we'll find another location Stateside
- 3. Beaver Creek, CO: Ski-in /out @ the Charter. Jan 15 22, 2022. Fly into local Eagle airport. (EPIC)
- 4. Lincoln, NH: Jan 23 28, 2022: Ski Loon, Waterville Valley, Bretton Woods and/or Cannon. Drive up trip
- 5. <u>Sunday River Pretrip</u> February 4 6, 2022: Your choice of the weekend at Sunday River OR a resort in NH. Either (EPIC) independent trip or a prequel to your week at Sunday River. Will be a drive-up (IKON)
- 6. Sunday River, ME February 6 11, 2022: 18th year of the OC's staying slope side @ the Summit Hotel. <u>Drive</u> <u>up</u> or bus ride. Standard Hotel rooms (no cooking facilities), Studios with Kitchenettes, 1 bd/ba with Living Room and Kitchen). Ski days: 4 or 5 days. (IKON).
- 7. Presidents Week Trip Feb 19 26, 2022: Salt Lake City, Brighton/Alta/Snowbird/Solitude (IKON)
- 8. <u>Presidents Week Trip Local...</u> I'm working on this for a trip to be Family inclusive w/o the added expense or heartache of air travel. Send me some suggestions...
- 9. 3rd "Western" Trip TBD (IKON or non)
- 10. 4th Western Trip TBD (EPIC or non)
- 11. Tremblant, QC Feb or March 2022: We really want to get you there (IKON)
- 12. **Bolton Valley** March 2022:
- 13. Lake Placid, Feb or March 2022 (IKON)
- 14. Courmayeur, Italy March 19- 30 (26): Rescheduled from 2020 trip. Motor coach ride ALB⇔JFk, Emirates Airlines for overnight flight to Milan, shuttle to ski resort, lodging with breakfast & dinner daily, shuttle to Lake Como for 3 night side trip which includes lodging, breakfast, & ½ day tour, shuttle back to Milan for flight to USA and return ride to ALB.
