

#### OC BOARD MEETING **HIGHLIGHTS – JUNE 2021**

The Board Meeting was held on Tuesday, June 2nd. We actually were able to meet in person, on my deck once again, now that the weather is warming up and the Covid restrictions are lifting. Here is a summary of what took place. Complete minutes are found on the website after the following Board Meeting.

- Those meeting restrictions of 50 people? GONE but with historically low attendance for the Summer months we will delay our return to the PCC until late Summer /early Fall.
- Volleyball League registrations began coming in April 15th and volleyball player renewals along with them. We may not see the complete return but a decent turnout is projected.
- Trip negotiations are in progress. Additional announcements will be made soon...
- **OC Golf Scramble:** The Club will subsidize \$15 for current members to signup for the scramble. The amnesty program for lapsed memberships ended on June 1st (for those who did not renew 20/21 or 4 years earlier) but the grace period for renewals still exists - til Sept 1st . The Scramble will be after that date so get those dues paid!!!
- WELCOME BACK Party will be held on June 4th Club's 60 1/2 Birthday as well as combining the Installation party for the incoming Officers & Board Members. Due to some scheduling conflicts we will not hold this on the actual birthday, coincidentally a Thursday (June 10th) but have scheduled for the 4th. #### 2021 / 2022 OC SKI CLUB ALPINE Trips Update

Many of us are anxious to get back out there travelling; my primary tour operator has told me that the inquiries are pouring in. However, the airlines are slow to release group pricing so far and the Canadian Border is not yet open to us Be forewarned, the deals are very scarce as the industry (air and resorts) try to recover from the year that did not happen for them.

One of our other local clubs has already offered a trip to Big Sky, in March, they had to grab this as Big Sky was already selling out their weeks. but in doing so they may have lost some negotiating power. Okay – it's a popular destination loved by all of the Capitol District ski clubs and the price is not so bad given what I am seeing out there right now.

We experienced many new things over the past year, some good & some not so good. I've learned that we can run smaller trips at a decent price but let's see what the offers are before I go too crazy. One of our "good" processes was to allow for early electronic signups with a refundable deposit. We are going to offer this again, but with some improvements we have researched and are in the process of development... (a REAL online registration form...).

Weekend trips will require a \$75 deposit + paypal fees (\$2.75) Sunday River & NH trips will require a \$100 deposit + paypal fees (\$3.50) Weeklong trips will require a \$150 deposit + paypal fees (\$5) Your deposit will be fully refundable (but not the pp fee) until a predetermined cutoff date; this date is determined by the resort and our contract. At the time of the cutoff you will then make the decision to drop out & receive your refund or to pay the remainder of the deposit which will then fall under the normal cancellation policies of the Club. - 1. <u>Dec 10 12 or Dec 17 19, 2021</u>: Our annual Lessons & Luxury trip. This is a Driveup, Family friendly trip with free lessons to those who would like them. Details to be determined
- 2. <u>New Year's Eve trip in December/January</u>. My hope is to return to Quebec City for skiing at Mt Ste Anne and Le Massif but if we cannot cross the border, we'll find another location Stateside
- 3. <u>Beaver Creek, CO January 15 22:</u> Ski-in /out @ the Charter. Fly into local Eagle airport; condos but also 2 <u>on-site restaurants. (EPIC)</u>
- 4. Lincoln, NH: Jan 23 28, 2022: Ski Loon, Waterville Valley, Bretton Woods and/or Cannon. Drive up trip
- 5. <u>Sunday River Pretrip</u> February 4 6, 2022: Your choice of the weekend at Sunday River OR a resort in NH. either independent trip or a prequel to your week at Sunday River. Will be a drive-up (IKON)
- Sunday River, ME February 6 11, 2022: 18<sup>th</sup> year of the OC's staying slope side @ the Summit Hotel. <u>Drive</u> <u>up</u> or bus ride. Standard Hotel rooms (no cooking facilities), Studios with Kitchenettes, 1 bd/ba with Living Room and Kitchen). Ski days: 4 or 5 days. (IKON)
- Presidents Week Trip Feb 19 26, 2022: Salt Lake City, Utah. Stay in SLC at the base of the 2 canyons to ski at Brighton, Solitude, Alta & Snowbird. Rooms with kitchenettes, breakfast included, close to shuttle to the mountains (IKON).
- 8. 3rd "Western" Trip TBD (IKON or EPIC???)
- 9. <u>Tremblant</u>, QC Feb or March 2022: We really want to get you there (IKON)
- 10. Bolton Valley March 2022:
- 11. Lake Placid, Feb or March 2022

12. **Courmayeur, Italy March 19- 30 (26):** Rescheduled from 2020 trip. Motor coach ride ALB⇔JFk, Emirates Airlines for overnight flight to Milan, shuttle to ski resort, lodging with breakfast & dinner daily, shuttle to Lake Como for 3 night side trip which includes lodging, breakfast, & ½ day tour, shuttle back to Milan for flight to home
