Usually by this time of year, we have all



our ducks in order. We have a schedule for our day ski trips with lift ticket

prices, the details for overnight trips including prices are published and we just have to decide where and when we want to ski with the club. But this is not a usual year and, once again, we face a degree of uncertainty concerning the upcoming ski season.

This is not to say that your ski committees have not been working diligently all summer, because they have. Their efforts have yielded both positive and some not so favorable results.

On the positive side, we already have a good number of week-long, mid-week and weekend trips on the schedule. Trips out West include Beaver Creek and Sun Peaks in January, Utah in February and Mt. Bachelor in March. Also in March is the long-awaited Italy trip. Mid-week and weekend trips include everyone's favorite, Sunday River, and Bolton Valley with mid-week and/or weekend options and Quebec City for New Year's Eve. Our day trips schedule is still in limbo as many of the resorts we normally visit have been unwilling to negotiate group lift ticket prices at this time because the resorts are also dealing with conditions of uncertainty themselves. We hope to have a schedule in place as soon as information from the resorts is forthcoming. In the meantime, we are planning to run buses and we have developed a bus policy which follows mandates set by Brown Coach, Inc. and

is in line with CDC and NYS Department of Health requirements. This policy is also subject to change as conditions change, so check the website at ocskiclub.org for updates.

We still need volunteers for all our upcoming events, especially for our Annual Volleyball Tournament which is to be held at Maple Ski Ridge on September 18. This is our biggest fundraiser which helps to support the club's buses and other events celebrating our great club. It is always a lot of fun that you don't want to miss, so volunteer and get in on the fun.

Winter Carnival is scheduled at Plattekill on February 17th when we have the whole mountain to ourselves. This will no doubt be a highlight of the season. Be sure to mark your calendars. We also need volunteers for the fun and games at Plattekill, so please let me know if you would like to participate.

It's just amazing that it's that time of year again. Time for our favorite place to be, on the mountain. I can't wait!

I have been reaching out to the mountains to see what the landscape looks like for accepting buses. Most mountains are still coming up with a plan for the season. There are new CDC guidelines, along with new mountain rules that have to be followed.

Here's what I know so far. Each mountain has advanced ticket purchases required. That means payment is due 3 days in advance. No more last-minute sign ups. Some mountains are requiring parking reservations. Those reservations are limited.

All bus transactions (lift ticket θ bus ride) are required to be prepaid. We have moved to a cashless system using PayPal. In the event of a cancellation, fees will not be refundable. Brown Coach, Inc. is currently requiring that we wear masks the entire ride. No bathrooms are open. No eating of food or drinks allowed. The front two seats, on both sides of the bus must be empty.

I expect to have a schedule ready by mid-November or early December. When updated information becomes available we will be passing it along. Please understand that everything is going to be subject to change. This year you might see a partial schedule with additions as we are able to secure workable ski dates. Be patient as we are doing all we can to come up with a winter plan.
