

The Board Meeting was held on Thursday, September 2<sup>nd</sup>. We met, once again, in person at the PCC before heading down to our 2nd in person membership meeting, which was not as well attended as the one in August. Could have been the proximity to the Holiday weekend or we are just not ready for the crowds again. Below is a summary of what took place. Complete minutes are found on the website after the following Board Meeting.
