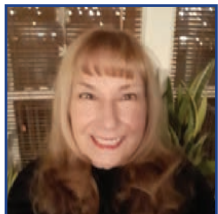

OC BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS – NOVEMBER 2021

The Board Meeting was held on Thursday, November 7th. Below is a summary of what took place at the Board meeting. Complete minutes are found on the website after the following Board Meeting.

Volleyball Tournament: Net Income from tournament was \$9,121 despite decrease in players/teams. Increase in fees to play and additional cost savings measurements are the underlying contributions to this increase. We've not seen income over \$7.5 k in many years. Budget was for \$6,000

Holiday Party/belated 60th Birthday Celebration: We will be signing the contracts with the Italian Community Center and a DJ service to provide the members with a party to celebrate the holidays and the 61st birthday of the Club (12.10.60). It will be a plated dinner and cash bar

Trips: Utah & Italy are sold out with waiting lists. Smuggs and Sunday River are selling quickly and will sell out. Quebec is going to be smaller than originally planned but still a nice sized group.

Bus Policy: Approved policy is now posted on the Website

Meeting resumption: We are getting back to normal with meetings most weeks in November and December. Holiday weeks will be determined at a later date

While sitting down to eat or Drink, the mask may be removed.

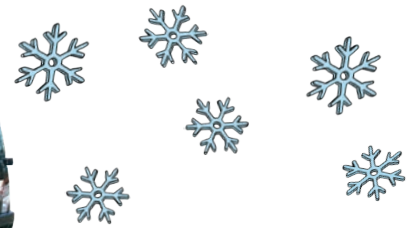

OC BUS COMMITTEE

It has always been the policy 21 seats sold to run a bus, 21 to get a group rate. Members also have always had the opportunity to join the bus and not buy a lift ticket. If the bus was canceled due to not enough sign ups you get your bus fee (\$12) back. There was no advance ticket purchase requirements. So what has changed?

COVID and Vail has provided The mountains the opportunity to rewrite the rules. So they did. The rest of the industry followed right down to the small mountains.

Now all mountains are requiring payment 3 to 5 days in advance for lift tickets. Along with advanced reservations required. No refunds on lift tickets once purchase is made. Except if we do not get enough for a group rate those riders get a full refund lift ticket and bus ride. No refund of PayPal fees, though. (Refund of PayPal purchase but not PayPal fees)



This is a strange concept for all of us. The variety of new definitions of what a group rate means is just as amazing. It has been 21 for a group rate for decades. Now it 15 for a group rate or 21 for a group rate. Yet another a group of any combination of 21 (season pass holders and lift ticket purchase) defines a

group. Some mountains will not take any groups at all. Others day no buses on weekends. Then some require parking reservations. With all these changes we were still able to pull together a ski program.

I feel as though COVID has brought a lot of changes to the way we plan our trips to the mountains. OC members during the pandemic continued to ski, the cheapest they could. That turned out to be with season passes. Of course, Given the direction lift tickets have gone. The very wrong direction! Get on line and look at e-tickets at any mountain. Crazy right? So now we have a lot of members with season passes. It's now a new normal per-say.

DAY BUS PAYPAL PURCHASES

In order to continue to bring you a bus schedule, we have been forced to make some changes. These changes are ripple effects from the pandemic and required by the mountains themselves. It is important for you to be informed on how they may or may not affect you. Before you sign up for a bus, take time to read the following:

- All bus transactions must be paid using PayPal. This includes lift tickets and bus rides. No exceptions.
- PayPal signups for Sunday buses close the prior **Tuesday at 6 PM.**
- PayPal signups for Friday buses close the prior **Sunday at 6 PM.**
- PayPal fees are non-refundable.
- Lift ticket purchases are non-refundable. The only exception is if there are not enough lift ticket purchases to qualify for the minimum number required by the mountain for the group price. In that case, the lift ticket price will be refundable via PayPal.
- For the most up to date information on bus cancellations OR group lift ticket purchase cancellations, please check the website (ocskiclub.org) and Facebook.

Target date for opening PayPal is Thanksgiving.
