

Then go to any ticket window showing your state ID, OC membership card, and council sticker. It's that easy to get a discounted ticket.

If you're bringing the kids along, make sure each kid has a club ID card to enjoy the New York Capital District Ski Council appreciation days. Just present the card and get the discount! These can be purchased for \$6 at the meetings.

Second Bus is Dec 3, 2023 Killington



Hope your Thanksgiving included a day on the slopes. Happy Holidays.

Buses are rolling. Dec 3 is Killington, Dec 10 is Stratton, Dec 15 is Whiteface, and Dec 17 is Gore. Buses roll as long as we have 21 sold seats. Lift tickets sales are a separate item and do not determine if we run a bus. Many members have passes and please use them even if you ride the bus. If you need a lift ticket, you have choices. Some mountains like Killington have given us a reduced price that you buy direct from the mountain using a code we supply on the Bus Calendar. The Bus Calendar is on the first page of OCskiclub.org website. Click on the date you want to ski and follow the directions. Others are Council Days, and you will purchase those lift tickets via the NYCDSC.org site. For Gore, Whiteface, and Belleayre, your best price is using the SKI3 card. This card is not available after Dec 14, so buy now to get the lowest lift ticket price available. We will have lift tickets for sale directly with the mountain, but they are not as cheap as the SKI3 pass. Again, instructions will be posted on the Bus Calendar for Gore and Whiteface lift tickets. I remind you that buses roll as long as we have sold 21 seats.

The website has been updated and made easier to navigate. All buses are listed on the OC BUS CALENDAR. Just scroll through the months to see what buses are going and where. Click on the date and get the specifics for that trip. Notice that we have listed the Ski Council Dates as well. We did take advantage of several of those days for buses. Stratton, Dec. 10 is the first of the Council Day buses. Killington, Pico, Stratton and Jiminy have granted Council Days so far. We are hoping for more mountains to participate.

Doing my snow dances and hoping for lots more snow. See you on the bus.

- 1) Bus sign up info is on this webpage (Note that we only list the next 4 or 5 weeks of buses for sign ups).
- 2) You will find two types of sign up options.
 - A) Bus Seat Only there will be multiple days on this button, select the day you want then process.
 - B) Sign Up Here Days with discounted Lift Ticket options (select dates only).
 - x) There will mulitple options for seat & lift ticket. Choose which one you want.
- 3) You can also sign up for buses at the PCC meetings or on a day ski bus.
- 4) If the bus unfortunatly gets canceled. You can get a refund at any PCC meeting from the Bus committee.
- 5) The "OC Bus Schedule" calendar will have updated/current info.



Happy Holidays to all our Family Ski Club Members and their families.

The Smuggler's Notch Trip is open and condos are filling up. Now is the time to contact Carrie Britt or Kelly Barlow about your reservation. Already snow is falling and the conditions are improving. By Jan 12, they should be perfect. Come to any meeting to complete your reservation.

Jamie Britt, the other sister, is opening Jay Peak, April 5-7, 2024, at the Nov 30 meeting. This trip will include the water park and 3 days of lift tickets for those staying at Hotel Jay. Stateside reservations will include lift tickets. You will be able to purchase water park tickets as an extra. Jamie will be at all OC meetings selling the trip.

Maple Ridge is again offering OC members and their families reduced priced lift tickets of \$25 Wednesday through Friday every week until season end. Just show your ID and OC membership card when purchasing a lift ticket. Other local mountains are such as Berkshire East, Catamount, Williard, West Mtn, and Butternut are being contacted about offering reduced lift tickets to OC members. More information is forthcoming.

As an OC Club member, you are also a member of the New York Capital District Ski Council. One perk is that mountains offer reduced lift tickets as part of the Ski Club Member Appreciation Days. Council Days (our nickname for these days) are listed on the OC Bus calendar. Killington, Pico, Jiminy Peak, and Stratton have already listed their days. You can purchase the lift tickets via the NYCDSC.org website.

If you are one of those people who did not already purchase an Epic, IKON, SKI3 or INDY pass or a season pass to a specific mountain, then I have news for you. Many mountains allow you to purchase lift tickets ahead of the date you want to ski. These pre-purchase tickets are for specific dates and usually non-refundable. That means they are "use it or lose it" tickets. However, the benefit is the ticket is much cheaper than if you went to the ticket window the day of skiing. Pico (P tickets) sells lift tickets this way. The price goes up the closer it is to the date of skiing.

Remember that you and your children (age 7 to 17) are welcome to ride the bus at the member price of \$12 per seat. Often we have reduced lift tickets for those bus dates. Riding the bus is fun, you get a bottle of water on the return trip, and everyone shares snacks. Sign up via the OC Bus Calendar for PayPal or come to any meeting to sign up for the bus. All seats are pre-paid. Guests are \$22.

The OC's have rented Plattekill Feb. 29, 2024, Thursday. More about that date to follow next month. It will include Winter Carnival and a race. Make sure you plan to be there for all the fun!

Highlights:

- 1) Looking for something the OC's have planned, here are ways to find it.
 - A) Go to the <u>Upcoming Events page</u> and check out the items there or look at the calendar.
 - B) Go to the OC Bus Page and check out the calendar for what is scheduled
 - x) This is where you can sign up for the bus too!
 - C) Go to the Ski Trip schedule page to find out where we are going this season.
- 2) Home page what is there?
 - A) The OC Bus schedule calendar link, click on it and it will direct you to the right page.
 - B) The Ski Trip Chart, click on the "Direct Link" and it will direct you to the right page.
 - C) Two Upcoming Events that we are highlighting
 - x) Looking for more events click the "More Events" box
- 3) Calendars
 - A) The "Upcoming Events and Trips" Calendar is just that! It basically has evertything in it except the bus schedule.
 - B) The "OC Bus Schedule" calendar is just that too! Everything about the day buses. Where are we going, lift ticket price & options, where do I go to get on the bus, etc.
 - x) The Bus committee will also put in a notification if unfortualty the bus has to be cancelled
- 4) Website navagation
 - A) Four major items that the OC Ski Club is all about. Skiing, Upcoming Events, Family and Volleyball. These items are always on the top of each webpage for you to select
 - B) There are no drop down menus. When you click to go to a new page there will be more selections to choose from on that page just under the page title.
 - x) example Go to Skiing, then go to Cross Country, then go to Day Bus. Bingo!
 - C) If you find that you get redirected away from the website, say to a PDF file we have, the easiest way back to where you were is to hit the "Back" button on your browser.
- 5) Looking for membership information, click on any the "Join OC Ski Club" boxes. This will direct you to the membership webpages. Even if you are a current member click on that box then select "Current Member" on the navagation bar
- 6) The website base layout is meant for viewing on a montior. The website is mobile friendly but all the information on the webpage might require more scrolling, etc. But this is true for most website.
