

At long last, here is a summary of the bus committee survey results. Because of the format of the survey, the results required considerable time and labor to process the results. Thank you to the 120 members of our club who took the time to respond. Only 2 respondents indicated that they had no intention of riding the bus this season. For all other questions, multiple responses for each question were typical.

Ski day preferences were evenly divided between Sundays (71) and Fridays (70). Many respondents indicated that they had multiple passes. Ikon was most popular (35) followed by Gore (32) and Epic (25) with 26 indicating they purchased various other passes. The average number of ski runs per day was 10 with quite a few people reporting 11+ runs per day.

The results of the question which asked which activities do you enjoy the most when riding the bus were not surprising. Socializing (102), meeting people (85) and skiing in groups (80) were the most popular responses. Many also responded that the free coaching (64) offered by our PSIA certified snow sports instruction team was appreciated. A number of responses also indicated that happy hour buses (63) would also be a plus to riding the bus and a few (22) might also enjoy themes and contests on the bus.

Most people who responded to the question about the new bus departure times liked them (65) with only 16 responding in the negative. Pico (72) was preferred for a mountain takeover day over Plattekill (46).

Only 9 people indicated that they would be willing to run a bus, which was a bit disappointing, especially since most who indicated willingness to run a bus trip are those who are usually willing to do so. New volunteers are always needed.

While a response of only 120 out of a membership of almost 1000 is not a very high response rate, nevertheless the information provided to the Bus Committee is valuable for future planning. Thanks again to those who chose to participate.
