Sept LiftLine article from Alpine Buses

Alpine Buses are starting the 2023-24 season with an outing to Big Snow in New Jersey, which is the 3rd largest mountain in New Jersey. We will run a bus Sept 30, Saturday. Pick up is 8 am at the regular pick up at Crossgates Mall (no second stop) and we leave the resort at 7:30 pm. Lift tickets are \$40 and purchased directly from Big Snow using the special promo code that is found on the OC website. As usual, you can pay for seats at meetings, Happy Hours or online at the OC website using PayPal. Seats are \$12 for members and their children ages 7-17. Guests are \$22. You will need your membership card for riding on the bus and also proper ID to pick up your lift ticket at Big Snow. It is a 2 hour ticket and the time starts when you actually get on the snow. Drive ups are allowed and you purchase the lift tickets directly online at the OC website. Our time slot is 11 am to 1 pm on Sept 30. Jeff Kenton says there will be lessons for anyone interested. Just contact him at meetings or Happy Hours. There is lots to do at the American Dream Mall which is located at the Meadowlands Sports Complex. There is an indoor amusement park, indoor waterpark, the Giants Stadium (tours), indoor ice rink, 2 indoor miniature golf courses, plenty of stores from Hermes to discount shops, and restaurants. Lots to keep everyone amused after skiing/riding. If Big Snow is a hit, we will repeat it Oct 21. This is the start.

Barb Sorrell and I (Sylvia Haefeli) are already shaping up the schedule for the season. Our aim is to get more mountains to give us discount tickets. The ski business is still evolving. Many members have purchased various season passes like Ikon, Epic, Indy and specific mountain passes. But there is still a large group of members who rely on the Club getting discount tickets. That is our goal this year. As members of the New York Capital District Ski Council (NYCDSC), you will have opportunities to enjoy Member Appreciation Discount Lift Tickets to several local ski areas. We will schedule buses to take advantage of these. Look for our next article in the October LiftLine and be sure to check out the OC website for more information as it becomes available.

Cynthia Ward NOTES FROM OC BOARD MEETING AUGUST 2023

The board met at the PCC on August 10th. Erin announced the dates of the coming HHs. The August HH at Maggie McFly's was well attended and another success. Thanks go to Judy Franze Tewey for arranging these gatherings. The September 20 HH will be at On Tap in Latham.

Erin has arranged for a boat cruise on Lake George for August 19 at 3:30 pm. If 20 sign up by August 12, the cost is \$30 or \$27 for seniors. If less than 20 want to participate the cost increases by \$5. Pay when you arrive.

Erin's nomination of Gail as Elections Chair was approved. Positions as chair of House, Fundraising and A&E have yet to be determined.

Membership statistics continue to improve. Online sign-ups, trip openings and emails are likely working to encourage the increase.

The first ski bus will run September 30th to the Meadowlands Sports Complex for some summer indoor skiing. A 2-hour skiing session is \$40 and the cost for gear rental excluding gloves is \$79.

The European trip to Val di Fassa, Italy will include a side trip to Milan. The trip will open as soon as details are confirmed. Since the Banff and Italy trips overlap, the attempt to stagger the dates, so members can attend both should they desire to do so, will be negotiated.

Smugg's has been scheduled for MLK weekend, January 12-15 with the same accommodations as before.

The 51st VB tournament is scheduled for September 16th with set up on the 15th and clean up on the 17th. The committee running the tournament this year includes Gail (Chair), Lynda, Jeff, Erin and Mark. As in the past, our biggest fundraiser and social event will include food and beer. Many volunteers are needed to ensure the success of this event. A letter soliciting volunteers will be emailed. Last year's tourney netted about \$8,000.

The web page Stage I update is underway with upcoming events listed and links to details. The calendar is now on the site with links as well. Stage II will include reviewing the site and updating content and remodeling which will be sent out for bids. This is not to be such a major change that will confuse our members, but should make the site easier for users to navigate. Thanks go to Fred Haefeli for taking the reins and spearheading the long-needed revision of the website.

Paying for a table at Freedom Park at \$100 as proposed by Frank Coleman was discussed. While a good idea, the cost appears to outweigh the benefits.

According to the OC Constitution, Applicant fees are currently at \$40; however, since the constitution was amended to remove this level of membership, the board discussed the need to designate fees for first year members. The term Applicant is now replaced with the term New Member in the Constitution and By-Laws. First year members (New Members) will continue to pay \$40 and will still be admitted to what was formerly called the Applicant Party for free.

Jeff reported that this year's snow expo at the Capital Center will be held November 11-12. He has negotiated that the OCs will have 4 booth spaces for the price of 3. Charges have been reduced for us from last year. More exhibitors and better attendance are expected this year.

It's back-to school time. Happy end of summer, Everyone!
