2024-25 Budget Proposal

In this fiscal year which ends May 31, 2025 we are projecting a budget deficit like last year, only smaller. The summary of this forecast is in the table below. We project that our dues, a little higher than last year, will continue to be lower than in prepandemic years. Public relations costs will be much lower now that the new website is complete. Ski bus expenses are the biggest unknown as usual. For budget purposes we are assuming a similar number of buses this year as last year but this may be wrong.

The net result is a projected loss of \$12,700. But considering we had large net surpluses during the pandemic years, a loss of this magnitude can easily be absorbed for several more years before we need to raise prices. The Board of Directors recommends the approval of this proposed budget which will be put to a vote next month.

Alpine Bus Committee

Welcome back, everyone. Like last year, the Downhill Bus Committee and the Cross Country Bus Committee are merged for this season. Barbara Sorrell, Cathy Marvin and I (Sylvia Haefeli) will co-chair the group. We are currently creating a schedule starting with October 26 - Big Snow, New Jersey. We have included the following mountains: Killington, Sugarbush, Pico, Okemo, Mt. Snow, Stratton, Magic, Gore, Whiteface, and Belleayre. We are hoping to add Bromley and Hunter to the mix. For Cross Country, we are talking with Mt. Top, Garnet, Viking Nordic, Prospect Mountain, Ole's Nordic, Mt. Van Hoevenberg, and Lapland Nordic. Pretty impressive list!

Where possible, both Alpine and Nordic will share buses. If Nordic increases in numbers, then they will start running their own separate buses. Our hope is the Nordic group increases dramatically in numbers over the season.

Browns Coach has informed us that the bus stop in Crossgates has moved across Washington Ave. Ext. to Crossgates Commons. The new stop will be to the rear of Walmart. The lot is off the lower level of Walmart. We are posting a map on the website to help you find the new location.

The second stop is at either Exit 12, Malta, in the lot opposite Panera's; or Rte. 7, Walmart. Park&Ride remains the same. The price of a seat has NOT changed - \$12 for members and their children (age 7-17) and guests \$22. Thank Leadership for holding the price down despite the increase in the price of buses. We still require a minimum of 21 riders for a bus to run. All seats are prepaid. Walk-ons must go to the second stop before loading. This is to make sure that everyone who prepaid has a seat.

Like last year, only 6 bus dates at a time will be available for signups on the website. Information about lift tickets will be explained with the bus sign-up. Each mountain is different. Those with passes — Epic, IKON, INDY, or season pass — can use them. If we get a discount price, there will be instructions on how to get the lift ticket. You can ride the bus and not ski, your choice. If you are interested in skiing/riding Sugarbush, January 24 (Friday) and April 4 (Friday), and you don't have an IKON pass, consider purchasing the "Best Deal" offer on the Sugarbush website. For \$99 + tax, you get a lift ticket for the January date and a bonus ticket to use for the April date. This is a limited-time offer.

Check out the Downhill pages on the OC website for information about lift ticket deals that are being offered this season. Caution - if you want to get the Vermont 4-pack, go to their website in the beginning of October to get the date of the sale. Last year they sold out in 15 minutes. Be ready to go on the site exactly at noon. They offer a wait list, and they did come back to those on the wait list with a chance to purchase the Vt4 pack. Be sure to put your name on the wait list. The Indy pass sold out last spring, but they also run a wait list and will contact those on the list with an opportunity to purchase the pass.

Weekly meetings start in October and we will be there to sell lift tickets and bus seats for Big Snow, which goes on sale mid-September on the website. Look for us in our usual place. Come chat. We are so ready to start the snow season this year. Snow dances are appreciated.

Hello OC Families!

We are back, planning for the 2024-25 ski season. The Smuggler's Notch and Jay Peak trips are scheduled. We have new trip leaders from the Family group. Chris Bendon and Colleen Bruecken Hudson will be the leaders for Smuggler's Notch, Martin Luther King Weekend, January 17-20, 2025. This is always a fun trip to a great mountain. April 4-6, 2025, are the dates for Jay and the leader will be Tracy Cook. Watch for the opening of Smuggs in October and, later in the fall, the opening of Jay. Both are drive-ups and families are welcome!

<u>Seasonal rentals</u>. So many children of members grow out of equipment, and it is costly to keep buying new or even used equipment for kids. But with a seasonal rental from one of the local ski shops, you get skis, boots, poles, and bindings (naturally) or snowboard with boots and bindings. They are professionally adjusted to your child's skill level, age, and yes, weight. And if the child grows

out of the boot size, you can go back to the shop and trade in the current boot for a bigger fitted boot. My grandson needed larger boots midseason last year. We went back to the shop and they fitted him and adjusted the ski bindings at no charge. So easy. Seasonal rentals are also **great for returning skiers** who have taken several years off and find their old skis so "out of date." Consider seasonal rentals also **for newbie adults** who want to learn but are not sure if they will enjoy the sport. Rentals at the mountain for one day cost almost as much as seasonal rentals from local shops! High Adventure, Rte. 7, Latham, just reopened for the season August 1. Play It Again Sports, Rte. 7, Latham, rents both skis and snowboard packages. Alphin Haus, Amsterdam and Clifton Park, also rent equipment. Consider Steiners in Glenmont and Valatie, Alpine Sports Shop, Saratoga Springs, or Sports Page, Queensbury, which specializes in racing equipment as well as general ski and snowboard. Tune Skis, Glenville, has snowboard, cross-country and downhill skiing rentals. These local shops have reasonable rates, provide maintenance, and support the local snowsports clubs.

Also be sure to **get your equipment tuned** at the beginning of the season, and during the season. Here in the east, we have ice and that means sharp edges. My rule of thumb is beginning, midseason, and, if I am going out west, then too. The Club has a professional ski school and provides clinics about boot fitting, stance, fitness and, best of all, tuning skis. Want to learn more? Talk to Jeff Kenton, our ski school director, at any meeting.

Next year beginning in August, the Family Committee will put on a workshop at the PCC on Board meeting night about seasonal rentals, answering all your questions. **Big Snow, NJ, Oct. 26, Saturda**y, will be the first official bus of the season. Kids (age 7-17) are welcome to ride the bus and drive-downs are allowed. You can pay for bus seats and 2-hour lift ticket: \$38.99 (a \$30 savings) via PayPal online September 17 or at meetings starting October 3. Big Snow is at the Meadowlands Sports Complex, NJ, and American Dream Mall. See the event schedule for details. The bus back won't leave until 6:30 p.m. This is a family event. Guests are welcome too!

Remember, the first stop for buses has changed -- now behind Crossgates Commons, across from the lower level of Walmart. See the map on the Alpine Bus web pages. Do those snow dances!
