OC Alpine & Nordic Buses

Yes! We are rolling for 2025. Happy New Year! Remember that both skiing groups ride the same bus. It is important that all your gear under the bus be labeled with your name, phone number and a **huge "A"** for Alpine or **"N"** for Nordic. That way, we are less likely to take the wrong gear off the bus when we arrive at the resorts.

January starts off with Jan 3 bus to Pico and Mt. Top, with a second stop at Exit 12. We will have a third stop at Excit 20 if someone signs up for it. The bus will arrive at Pico first and then go to Mt. Top where it will stay until 3:30. The bus will return to Pico at 4:00 and leave the mountain promptly at 4:30. This means everyone needs to be aware of the where and when the bus is at your stop. Questions, ask the bus leader. The schedule is found on almost every page of our website. It is a PDF that you can download and print out. Many take pictures of the schedule on the wall at our meetings; however, that schedule has some errors and we are reprinting it for use at future meetings. So use the website; don't rely on a photograph you took. Barbara, Cathy or/and I (Sylvia) are at every meeting. You can pay for seats at meetings, by PayPal online, or on the bus. Lots of options! Use them. Pray for MORE SNOW!

VP for Administration

- o Membership Stats our numbers are only slightly behind this time last year
- o Activities coming up: Happy Hour (12/18, O'Tooles), Holiday Party with 76 signed up to date (12/7)
- o Branded socks and shirts are now available at Fundraising. Thanks to Rex and Fred, a small number of each item were ordered to test their appeal to the members.

VP for Organized Skiing

- o Buses are rolling. The December 8 bus to Killington is a go.
- o Forty participants are attending the Whiteface Trip.
- o Winter Carnival is scheduled for Pico on March 14.

Old Business

o A discussion of the price of membership focused on the confusion and frustration expressed by members. The issue is that membership is advertised as \$35 for renewal and \$40 for first-time members; however, when they go to pay, an additional mandatory dollar is charged for mailing and an optional dollar for lamination. It should be made clear that the cost of membership is really at least \$36 or \$41 plus the \$1 for lamination.

New Business

- o Sylvia Haefeli to be appointed to the position of NYCDSC Representative
- o Rick Hurley initiated a lively discussion of the 3rd bus stop at Exit 20 to accommodate skiers on buses heading north. Rick suggested that this would also include growth of XC skiers as they also now share buses with downhill skiers and riders. Requiring a minimum of 5 signups is a deterrent to many who might take advantage of the bus. As a result, a motion to eliminate the 5-person minimum at the 3rd stop for this season as a trial, made by Matt and seconded by Sylvia, was approved.
