


OC Annual Golf Tournament Sunday, September 21

We also accept local people who are interested in our Club's activities in the hope that at some point they will join the Club once they see how cool we are. So far we have over 700 people on this group page, which is great, and we hope to add more as time goes by.

#### The two main reasons for this article are:

- 1. We want more of you to post what you have been doing. Skiing, obviously, but also other activities like hiking, biking, concerts, boating, etc. This is the OC's Social Community Hub. Let others see that the OCs are a fun-loving group. This will encourage non-members to want to join our great ski club.
- 2. Not necessarily new, but the other reason for our Facebook group is to let others know what you are also planning on doing. In the past OCs were always letting others know, for example, "Hey, Champagne in the Park is next Thursday let's meet up!" or "Going to hike up to the snow hole on Saturday want to join us?" As noted, this Facebook group is the OC's Social Community Hub, so we want everyone to post often!
