

65th

Member Profile



In every LiftLine issue this year – leading up to our Club's 65th anniversary this December 2025 -- an OC member will be highlighted. All our members lead interesting lives. My goal is to share those "lives."

This month it's **Bob Domanico's** turn. "**Bobbyd**," as he is affectionately known in the Club, is a man of the world! He learned to ski in the Air Force when he was based in the Italian Dolomites. A small ski mountain, Piancavallo, was located near the base and became his favorite R&R slope. He loved the snow and skiing. Then home to the US: marriage, family, work took over. Skiing was put on a "back burner."

In 1999 following a change in life, Bobbyd decided to return to skiing. After his divorce, he realized he needed to make new friends and carve out a new social life. His children were teenagers and making their own social circles that did not include Mom and Dad. Bobbyd was working at the West Milton military base as a union construction worker and boilermaker, and worked fueling and refueling the nuclear reactors that the Navy used at its training facility. Bobby d got to work with engineers who designed the newest prototypes by helping implement changes, as a worker bee. It was exciting work but he wanted more. Skiing offered that more.

He found like-thinking fellow workers who joined him on skiing adventures. The equipment had changed radically from the 1970s and Bobby wanted to find someone who could teach him the new technique that didn't cost a fortune. In 2001, Bobby discovered the OC Ski Club and its FREE ski school. A perfect fit.

In 2009, Bobbyd retired. He needed to find a new outlet for his energy and wanted to give back to the community. At first, he volunteered with the Salvation Army and then in 2010 switched over to the Red Cross.

Hurricane Irene hit Schoharie County hard. Bobbyd volunteered to help with the cleanup. The Red Cross offers continuous training to all their volunteers while they are helping. They believe that their volunteers should be trained on how to best help a struggling community. That includes the emotional part – for people who have lost everything, and need not only physical support but also emotional support. Not just for the immediate moment but for the long haul as they rebuild their homes, businesses, families and lives.

This approach appealed to Bobbyd. He says that the people skills of empathy and compassion are as important as technical skills when working with desperate people. He has been a Red Cross volunteer ever since, willing to deploy at a moment's notice to help others whose lives have been turned upside down by Mother Nature.

As skiing became more important in Bobbyd's life, he was interested in experiencing far-off ski mountains. OC trips attracted him. Because he is a natural born volunteer, he offered to lead OC trips, in the Northeast, out West and then Europe. Bobbyd is a second-generation Italian American and speaks Italian, an asset as a trip leader. Not only did he lead trips, ride ski buses and frolic with Club members, Bobbyd became involved with the running of the Club and offered his expertise. He was elected several times to the Board of Directors and served as President 2012-2014.

Any time you need a laugh, or want a fellow practical joker, or even someone to race down a slope with, call on Bobbyd. He is always available to participate in OC FUN!






