

For me to order enough food and supplies I would kindly ask that you sign up by September 4th. Please go to [OC Picnic webpage](#) to see more details and sign up through PayPal at "Picnic PayPal Button" in the green bar; or sign up at the meeting September 4th.

Become a member of our great Club and pay \$15, or as a guest pay \$20.

You are allowed to bring your own alcoholic beverages, but the park rule is, no glass on the beach. We will provide bottled water. **Please bring a chair and a dish to share.** You may want to bring towels, sunscreen, beach umbrella and any games you'd like to share. We are planning on the usual hamburgers and hot dogs and adding some marinated grilled chicken.

Member Profile

OC member **Annie Curto** shared with us this wonderful legacy of **Four Generations** of skiing family history.

My skiing story starts with family ties to the 10th Mountain Division. My mother's first cousin married Andy Petruska. He served with the 10th Mountain Division during WWII and when he returned, he started Andy's Sporting Goods in Troy and later expanded with stores in Latham and Stuyvesant Plaza. Andy provided my family with inexpensive used equipment, and his sons taught us to ski in 1960. My twin sister and I were 5 years old, and our brother was 6. My Dad learned too at 37 so he could take all of us skiing. Dad was an amazing man. For many years we all went to Willard Mountain every Sunday with the Petruskas, the skiing Renzis of Waterford.

I married my high school sweetheart, Nick Curto, who had a similar childhood. In fact, our families were probably at Willard at the same time. He and I skied together many weekends and went on trips to Whiteface, Sugarbush, and Mt. Tremblant. We married and continued the family tradition of skiing at Willard. My twin sister moved to California after college. I asked her why - wouldn't she miss skiing? It was then I found out that she never liked it. She only went because we all did. Who is this person??



I taught our daughter Amelia to ski when she was 5. Living in Schaghticoke, I started instructing at close-by Willard and did so until Amelia was 11. (By then my husband Nick had to quit due to health reasons.) She joined the weekly lessons at Willard through her school ski club. I continued skiing with family and friends and joined the OC Ski Club to take advantage of the day buses to local mountains.

I started our granddaughter Zoey at 5. She also took lessons at Willard and Gore, and joined her school's ski club lesson group. Unfortunately, my daughter Amelia had to stop skiing about 6 years ago due to health issues. I continued to take Zoey and her friends skiing. Zoey is now old enough to drive so she doesn't need Nanny to take her anymore.

But the legacy continues... Today I still ski with cousin Dave Petruska – Andy's son and my best friend. We have continued to carry on the legacy with season passes to Gore. 
We Have a Facebook Group Page!

As you might know, the **OC Ski Club has a Facebook group page**, "The Out of Control Ski Club."
