Still Time to Protect Your Trip — Why Travel Insurance Matters

Alpine & Nordic Bus Committee

Winter is coming, the first snows are being recorded on the northeastern mountain tops. Get your gear out, tune it up, and start planning your winter trips.




I hope by now, you have purchased your passes – Epic, Ikon, Indy, Frequent skier card, Best Buy at Sugarbush, what ever you need to make your season great!

The Bus schedule is posted online (download and print it from the [OC website](#)) and posted at every regular meeting. Our first bus is Dec. 7th, Sunday to Killington. We will start selling seats at the Happy Hour, Nov 25 at Smokey Bones. The table will open Dec. 4. Josh Nixon, Barbara Sorrell and myself (Sylvia Haefeli) will be available every meeting to sell seats, answer questions, and provide guidance on bus protocol.

We are keeping the 3 stops going north for Gore, Whiteface, Killington, Pico, and Okemo if we can add that mountain to our schedule. There are 2 stops going east to Stratton and Mt. Snow. We have lowered the age limit for children to 5. Children 5 to 17 can ride the bus with a parent or guardian at the member price. The OC Ski Club does not offer a Jr membership but children are welcome at all meetings, events, bus trips, and overnight trips. For more information on bus stops and rules, visit the OC website.

We keep 6 buses active on the website for PayPal purchases. As one bus goes, another is added to the six. You can purchase a seat at meetings in cash or check, online using PayPal and your credit card, and on buses (again cash or check) for future buses. We are always looking for volunteers to run the bus. If you are interested, please plan on attending a **bus training session Nov 13 or Dec.18**. Training takes about one hour. Bus leaders get their seat free. Being a bus leader no longer requires purchasing lift tickets. Just making sure everyone on the bus paid for a seat and selling future rides on the return trip.

Bus seats for members and their children 5-17 years are \$12. Guests pay \$22. Guests can decide to join the Ski Club on the bus and have \$10 applied to their membership price. Discount lift tickets, if available, will be sold via the Internet only. Either we supply a discount code the week before the bus trip or you pay online or at a meeting for a lift ticket; this will probably apply to Gore and Whiteface. A minimum of 15 tickets sold is required to get the discount price. Stratton, Killington and Pico will supply a discount code and you purchase your lift ticket directly from the mountain. Not sure at this time, about Sugarbush and Mt Snow. The cross country resorts will usually offer \$5 or more discount to the entire group when they arrive and buy their trail passes.

Once again we are going to have both X Ctry and downhill groups on the same bus. The X Ctry will also run a monthly Saturday bus to “where the snow is best” resort. That decision will probably be made on the Tuesday before the bus goes.

Cancellations: We will announce any cancellations at meetings, Happy Hours, and online: Website, Facebook and Instagram. I will send emails and text messages to those who have already paid for a seat on a canceled bus. That’s why we need your phone number when you sign up in person, and your email and phone number when you sign up on the web.

Theme buses: We want to add fun to our bus rides. We will do more tailgates, Heaney Weenie roasts, and bus high jinks. The first bus to Killington Dec. 7th will have a **Jello Posse competition** on the return trip: both alcoholic and nonalcoholic jello shots will be tested. After tasting the jello shots on the return trip, the riders will choose the best tasting, best appearance, and best kid fun ones. If you have never made jello shots, stop by the table for recipe and suggestions. Usually one box of jello is needed and a little creativity. We will definitely have a **Dec Santa bus too!**

OC SNOWSPORTS SCHOOL**



Thursday, November 20. PCC 6:00 PM - STANCE & BALANCE BOOT CLINIC. An annual clinic on what you need to know about ski boots and how they affect your skiing comfort and performance. Also an opportunity for an update on the latest with all ski equipment. Garrick Dardani, Steiner's Sports master boot fitter, will present.

Thursday, December 11. PCC 6:00 PM - CONDITIONING & PREVENTING SKI INJURIES. Injuries and wear and tear on the knees and other weight bearing joints are unfortunately common among skiers. Learn about types of ski injuries and how to prevent them with Kelly Chang, a physical therapist and avid skier. The clinic will include 15-20 minutes of education followed by a strength and conditioning circuit designed specifically for skiers to build strength and prevent injuries. Wear gym clothes if you wish to participate.

Thursday, January 15, 2026. PCC 6:00 PM - SKI CARE & TUNING CLINIC. Another annual clinic where you can learn how to take care of your skis, minor maintenance and repairs for the do-it-yourselfer, and what to look for when buying used skis, etc. A complete sharpen and wax tune-up will be done at this clinic. This clinic will be led by OC Snowsports School Director, Jeff Kenton.



OC Snowsports School is a PSIA-certified school providing coaching as a free benefit for all members. Our instructors will be available whenever we run a single-day bus. As in the past, there will be at least three private lesson days where you can request your instructor for individual feedback. This season we are planning on making instructors available on some of the drive-up days. To do so I need some information: Where and when you ski on drive-up days, do you have a pass (IKON, EPIC, SKI3, etc.), is there an instructor you would like to request? You can send this information to skiinstruction@ocskiclub.org or see me at a meeting or Happy Hour.
