Sign Up for Trips at OC Happy Hours!

Thinking about signing up for one of our trips? Come join us at Happy Hour to chat about the trip, meet other members, ask questions, and secure your spot! See the Happy Hour page in every issue.

To sign up, please bring your deposit payment by cash or check. You'll be asked to complete a short online questionnaire from your cell phone. This first form will create your official timestamp and place in line for the trip.

You do not need to have all your trip details ready at Happy Hour. However, after the event, you will receive a link by email to complete the full trip application. The detailed application will require more information and includes questions that cannot be skipped.

We ask that all applications be submitted within 24 hours to guarantee your spot on the trip. If the application is not completed within that timeframe, your spot may move to the back of the line.

Please note:

- Completing the online form alone does not confirm your spot on the trip.
- **Your spot is only confirmed once your detailed application is fully completed, your payment is received and accepted, and you receive an email confirmation from the Trip Leader.**

When completing the detailed application, please be prepared with information such as:

- Emergency contact information
- Roommate requests
- Ski/pass information
- Membership information
- Passport information (for international trips)
- Airline-required details including your full legal name exactly as it appears on your ID or passport
- Any additional air travel information requested for ticketing purposes

We've updated this policy because many trip applications have remained incomplete, creating a significant amount of follow-up and administrative work for Trip Leaders. Our goal is to make the sign-up process smoother, more accurate, and more efficient for everyone involved.

Having your information ready before filling out the detailed application will help avoid delays and reduce the need for Trip Leaders to chase down missing information later.

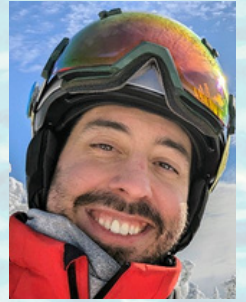

July 2026 Board Meeting Minutes

Your Board of Directors met in July and continued its work preparing for the upcoming 2026–2027 season.

The Board received reports from the Treasurer, VP for Administration, VP for Skiing, and committee chairs covering club operations, membership, marketing, and upcoming events. Membership continues to grow, with 462 members already registered for the new club year as of July.

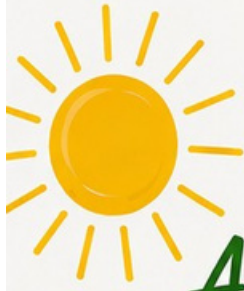
Several items of old business were reviewed, including proposed updates to the club's Recognition Policy and continued work on revisions to the Constitution and Bylaws. These discussions are part of the Board's ongoing effort to keep club policies current and reflective of today's operations.

Under new business, the Board approved the purchase of a dedicated laptop computer and USB hub for the Alpine Trips Committee to support trip operations, online registrations, volunteer training, and continuity for future volunteers. The Board also received an update on the club's online payment platform, reviewed plans for the annual picnic, and continued discussions regarding insurance coverage for the club and its officers.

Planning for the ski season continues at a steady pace. Trip registrations are off to a strong start, and volunteers across many committees are working behind the scenes to prepare for another successful year. As always, thank you to everyone who volunteers their time to support the OC Ski Club. We appreciate all that you do.

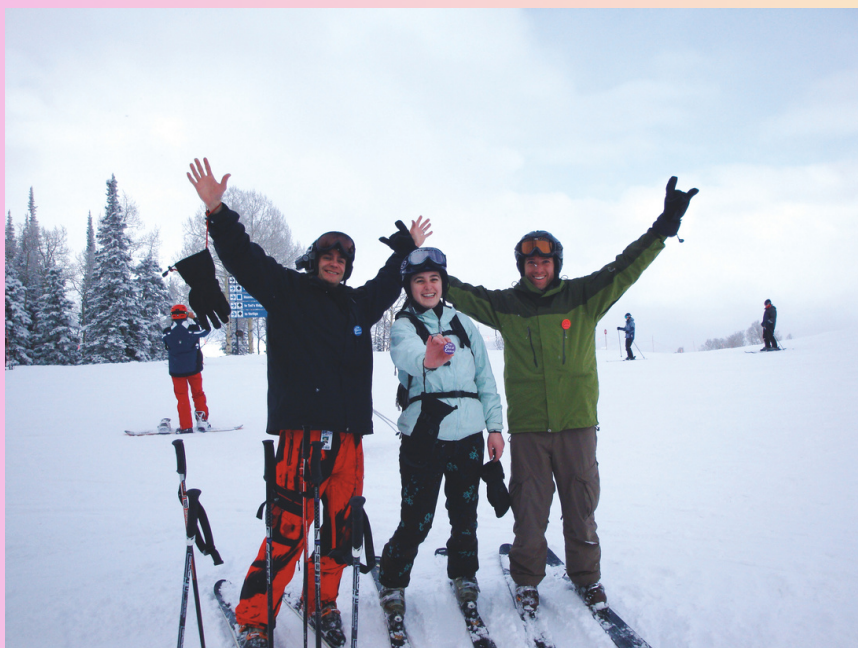
