WEEKLY ALPINE SKI BUSES

This is what this Ski Club does — We go skiing twice a week.

Weekday buses — Typically starting in December, the Ski Club runs buses every Friday until late in March or early April.

Weekend buses — Typically the first weekend bus starts around late November and will run until the end of April if not into May. Yes we like to ski.

Happy Hour buses — These buses are typically scheduled for Saturdays. The same as a weekend bus but staying at the ski resort a little longer for après' ski activities

Special mid-week buses — Check the bus schedule for dates other than Friday, Saturday or Sunday.

The Bus Schedule — Always updated on the OC Website. There is also a copy at the regular weekly meetings at the PCC

How do I get on a bus? — To “reserve” a seat on any bus you must pre-pay the bus fee only. You can do this through PayPal on the OC website, at a weekly meeting at the PCC or on a ski bus.

Where do I get on the bus?— All buses start in Albany. There are secondary pick-up locations depending on which ski area the Ski Club is going to that day. That information is on the bus schedule sheet. [Bus pickup locations](#)
